

USF Continuing Education Parking Information

USF POLICY REQUIRES PARKING PERMITS FOR ALL VEHICLES PARKED ON CAMPUS, 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK.

Parking lot 38C in front of NEC building is a mixed-use lot with areas designated for Nonresident Students [S], Staff [E], and Daily/Visitor [D]. Please pay attention to signage and make sure that you have paid for parking and your vehicle is parked in the correct area for your permit type.

Noncredit Continuing Education Students: Between 7am and 5:30pm on designated class dates, noncredit students with a valid USF parking permit may park only in designated Nonresident Student [S] and Daily/Visitor [D] non-numbered spaces. You must have a paid permit issued by USF Continuing Education (gold color) or USF Parking Services during those hours.

Visitors: Visitors may park in the designated Daily/Visitor lot [D] with a valid daily permit issued through a USF Parking Pay Station. You may purchase a daily permit for \$5 for use in non-numbered spaces or a reduced rate for time-limited numbered spaces. Parking Pay Stations only accept Visa/Mastercard. Visitors may park up to 3 times per semester with a complimentary daily permit in Park-n-Ride lots 18 and 43. These permits are available through the Campus Information Center or Parking Services main office.

Additional Parking Information: Between 5:30pm and 7am, vehicles displaying a valid USF permit (Park-n-Ride excluded) may park at no additional charge in [S], [E] and [D] lots, but not in any reserved resident lots, reserved spaces, state vehicle spaces, or disabled parking (unless displaying a valid state-issued disabled permit along with the USF permit). Do not alter or change information on your permit. Vehicles displaying altered/changed permits will be issued a citation and the vehicle immobilized. If your permit is lost, you may purchase a replacement permit.
