Register online at www.conted.usf.edu/testprep or call 813-974-2403 (toll-free in Florida 866-541-7124), option 1. Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, and American Express, and company-approved purchase orders accepted. **Personal checks, money orders and cash are not accepted.**

Register at least a week before the course start date to allow your confirmation materials and parking permit to be mailed in time. If you do not receive a confirmation of registration within 7-10 days of registering, call 813-974-2403 to verify enrollment.
